

Taitoniekantie 9 A, B, C, D, and E Apartments and Nuuskakuja 2 D and E Apartments

The fiber optical modem has been installed in the apartment's distribution cabinet, which is usually located in the hallway. The cabinet contains a short connection cable, allowing the resident to choose whether to connect to network sockets 1 or 2 in the apartment. It is recommended to install a WLAN router behind one of these network sockets.

Activating the Connection:

1. Open the apartment's distribution cabinet
2. Connect the cable to the fiber optic modem located in the distribution cabinet.
3. Connect the other end of the cable to the desired port of the network socket. The ports are labeled with numbers, and the corresponding numbers can be found on the apartment's computer network sockets. Once this connection is made, the network is available at the selected socket.
4. You can now connect your computer directly to the selected network socket using a cable. Because of security reasons, we recommend using a WLAN router.

Note: To use a wireless network, you will need a separate router that connects to the data outlet.



Taitoniekantie F, H, J, R, S, and T

The fiber optical modem is installed at the bottom of the wall in a room. In two-room apartments, the fiber optical modem is in the living room, and in shared apartments, each individual room has its own fiber terminal. In some rooms of the R and S buildings, a WLAN router provided by Lounea is already in use.

Setting up a Wireless Network (WLAN):

1. Ensure that the modem is on, and the network connection is active.
2. To connect to your modem's WLAN, you need two pieces of information: the network name (SSID) and the password. In new modems, these details are often found on a sticker on the bottom or back panel of the device.
3. Next, take the device you wish to connect to the WLAN.
 - a. Smartphone or tablet: Open the "Settings" menu and look for "Connections" or "WiFi."



- b. PC or laptop: Click the network icon in the bottom-right corner of the screen.
4. The device will scan all available wireless networks in the area and display a list. Select the network name (SSID) found on the modem's sticker.
5. The device will then prompt you for the network password, which is also located on the modem's sticker. Carefully enter the password (Password / WiFi Key), ensuring that every character is correct. Then, select "Connect."
6. The connection is now established.

Activating the Connection:

1. Identify the location of the network socket in the apartment.
2. Connect your WLAN router or device to the Ethernet connector on the network socket using an Ethernet cable.
3. Because of security reasons, we recommend using a WLAN router.



Emännäntie 10 K, L, M, O, and P and Vehkakuja 2 A, B, and C

In shared apartments, each room has its own network socket. In one-room and two-room apartments, the network socket is in the living room. In some apartments in the M and N buildings on Emännäntie, a WLAN router is already provided.

Activating the Connection:

1. Identify the location of the network socket in the apartment.
2. Connect your WLAN router or device to the Ethernet connector on the network socket using an Ethernet cable.
3. For security reasons, we recommend using a WLAN router.

Setting up a Wireless Network (WLAN):

1. Ensure that the modem is on, and the network connection is active.
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5. The device will then prompt you for the network password, which is also located on the modem's sticker. Carefully enter the password (Password / WiFi Key), ensuring that every character is correct. Then, select "Connect."
6. The connection is now established.
